

REGENCY PROFESSIONAL CARE SERVICES

Blood Pressure only

Pacemaker Check ó 1x monthly

Special Diet Program ó consultation

Laboratory Work ó blood tests, urinalysis, X-rays or EKG can be arranged at Regency Senior Communities through the Nurse with a Physician's order

Medication Set-Up ó Licensed Nurse sets up medications weekly in specially marked container for resident to take as directed

Medication Pick-Up ó when a new prescription is required, but the pharmacy, resident, or resident's family is unable to have it filled and delivered, the Nurse will make arrangements to have the prescription filled and delivered

Medication Supervision ó medications are taken to the resident in their residence, dining room, the Health Office, or a combination

Acquisition of Prescription Medications ó for residents not participating in Medication Set-Up or Supervision services who would like assistance in acquiring medications, they may request assistance from the Licensed Nurse in Health Services

Injections ó medications

Diabetic Monitoring ó testing, reading, recording

Insulin Services:

- Pre-Fills ó insulin syringes prepared and left with resident for self-injection
- Supervision ó health staff observation of resident self-administering insulin injection
- Injections ó for residents who are unable to self-inject insulin

•Sharps disposal

Oxygen ó assistance with setting equipment at ordered rate, setting up, changing tanks

Oxygen Assistance ó assistance with filling of portable liquid oxygen tanks, adjustment of flow, humidifier maintenance, use of concentrators, and non-liquid oxygen

Podiatry Services

Hearing Aids

- Assistance ó help placing and adjusting hearing aid
- Services ó hearing tests, hearing aid adjustments, battery purchase

Professional Cares ó such as dressing change, wound care, test preparation, etc. within residence

Medicare Reimbursable Professional Cares and Therapy Services:

- Post-hospitalization care
- Wound care
- Pain management
- Diabetic monitoring, teaching, injections
- Physical therapy
- Occupational therapy
- Speech therapy

Incontinence Management ó residents must be able to manage their own incontinence on admission, however, if incontinence develops, services such as bathing, product pick-up, bathroom cleaning, linen change and laundry are available

Physician Appointments and Collaboration ó the Health Office will provide a current list of medications and a Physician Visit Sheet for the physician to update during an appointment, so when the resident returns their chart and Emergency File are kept up to date

Guided Care ó provides for both the physical and cognitive needs of the resident utilizing specialized approaches in all service provisions with the goal of promoting mental, social, physical and spiritual stimulation in a safe and nurturing environment

Cardiac Monitoring ó under the order of the Physician or as recommended by health professionals, may include monitoring of pulse, blood pressure, weight and edema

Weight Checks ó additional weight checks by order of the Physician that go beyond the weekly health clinic services or in addition to cardiac monitoring
